SESSION TOPICS INCLUDE:

- **A New Journey:** Understanding how families grieve when a child has a disability.
- **An Empowerment Framework:** Understand how having a child with a disability affects different aspects of life.
- **Introduction to Special Education:** An overview of the laws governing special education, and the different responsibilities of parents, students, and educators.
- **Introduction to Private and Public Health Care:** Using insurance to meet the child's medical and therapeutic needs.
- **Introduction to Community Resources:** Understanding what community-based resources are available to help children with special needs and their families.
- **Envisioning a New Future:** A panel of parents share their experiences and advice to help young families build a new vision of the future.
